

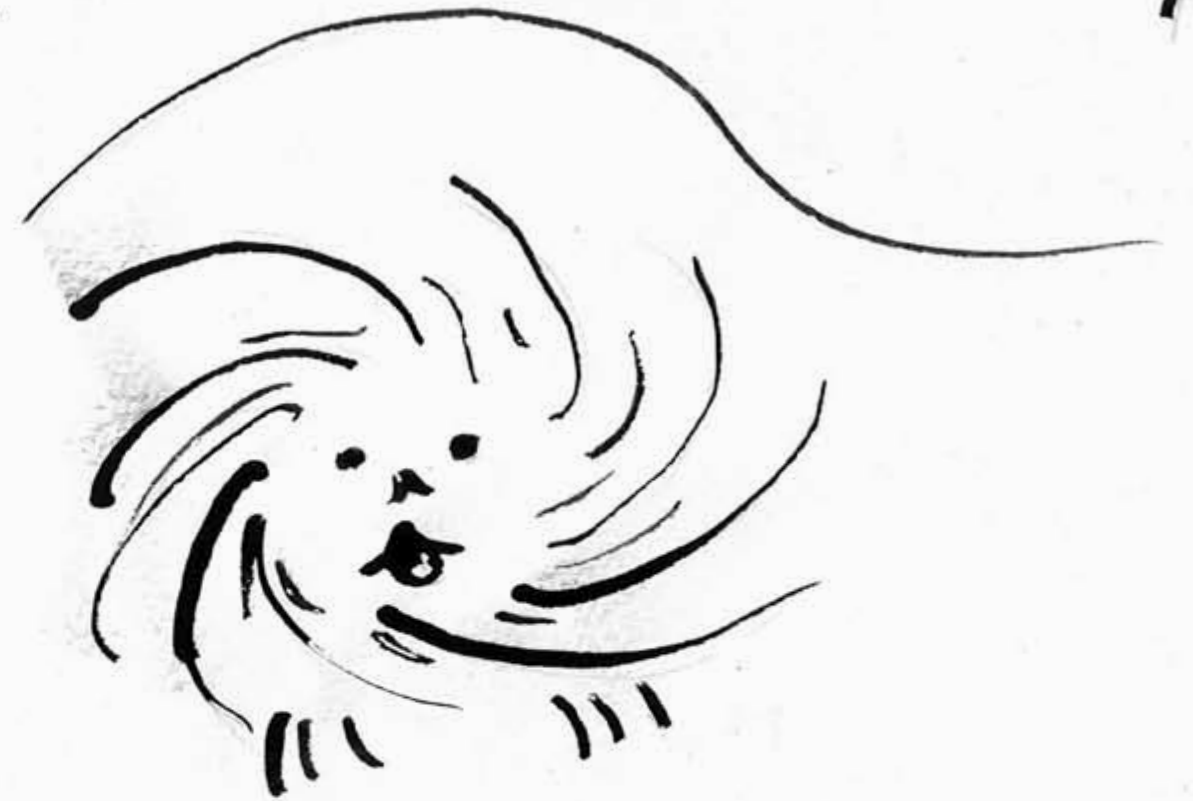

because that's what best friends do.

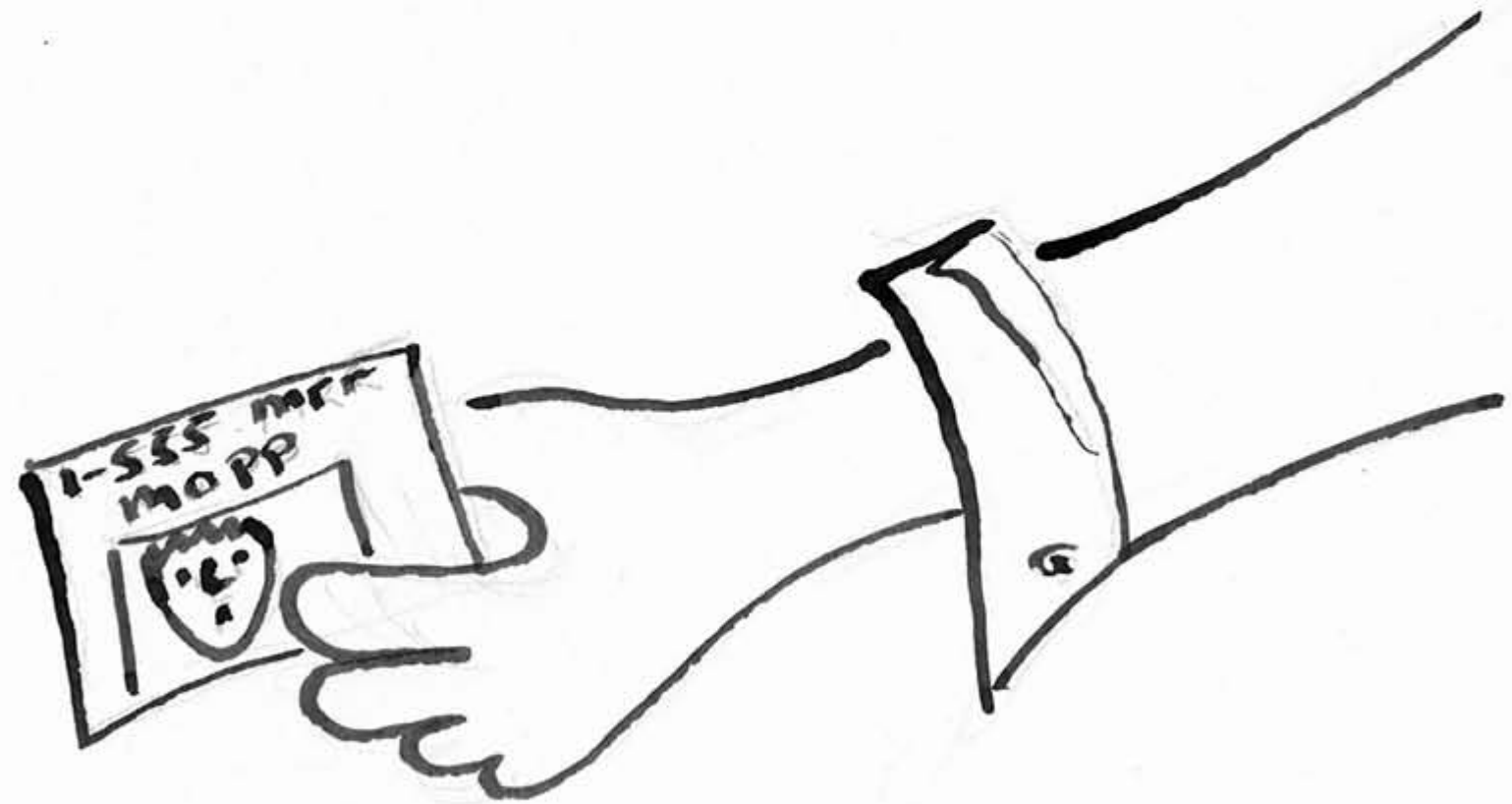
A chool!

Trouble?

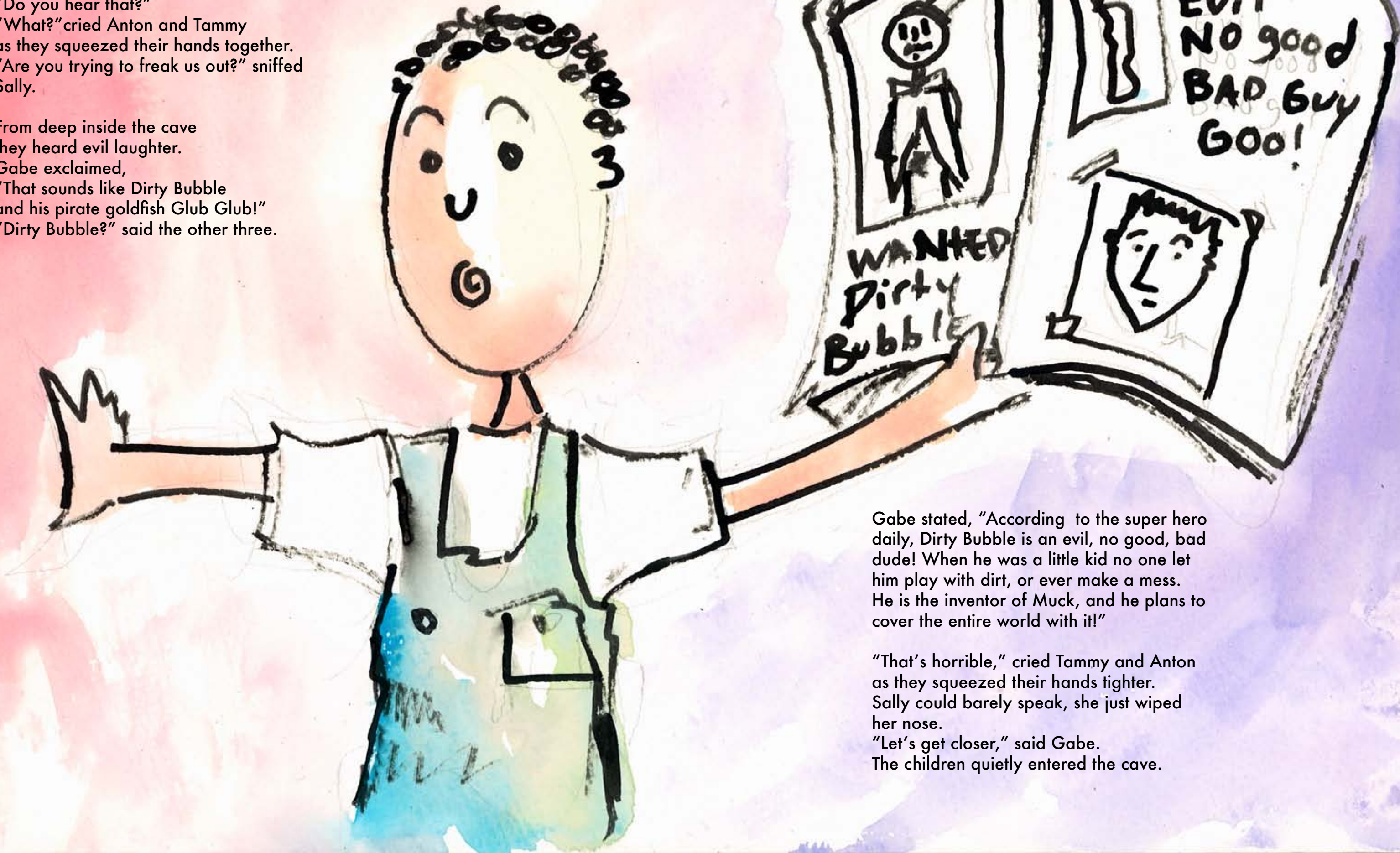


The kids ate their lunch in the parking lot of Mount Saint Helens.
